Happy May! Wow, it's June! It is always an exciting, yet bittersweet, month for us. There is so much to look forward to, and so much to celebrate. We are very proud of the children and how they have worked hard, learned lots and grown up much! We look forward to celebrating them on Tuesday, June 18th. Please note that we have decided to start the celebration at 11:30 AM so that we have more time for the special day.

Themes for this month are oceans and beaches, ecosystems, gardening, camping, and graduation. In math, we will work on understanding and counting teen numbers. Then we will move on to count to 50 by ones. Letters X, Y, and Z will guide us through "Letter Learning" (phonics), and we will review all of the vowel sounds what we learned A, I, O. We will continue thinking about, and understanding, the books we read together by identifying the beginning, middle and end of a story; thinking about the characters, their traits and their feelings; as well as, the setting. In science, we continue to learn planting, seeding, watering, photosynthesis, and observe a variety of phenomenon. We all did seeding some Zinnia, Marigolds and they all sprouted nicely. We observed daily basis how new roots and leaves are growing day by day. Creativity is also abundant in the Blue Room as the children lead their own projects and dive into those we present while often expanding on them with their own ideas.
