


September 2024

Welcome to the Yellow Kindergarten Room Arden, Arthur, Bennett, Enzo, Grant, Henry, Jack, Lukas, Lyla, Prue, Raegan, Riley L., Riley S., and Sage! We are excited to get to know you and your families. We have so many wonderful things planned to stimulate academic, physical, emotional and social development.

We will start off the year by taking the time to get to know each other and learn our kindergarten classroom routines, responsibilities and expectations, which are invaluable to starting a new school year. Please be on the lookout for activities to complete at home that will support this at school. Turn taking with classroom helper jobs will be an integral part of our day as we learn responsibility and pride in being part of a classroom community of learners and helpers. We will also use this time to build confidence and independence, as well as celebrate each of our unique qualities, as we participate in many What Makes Me and My Family Special activities. Throughout the month of September, we will introduce our math curriculum and dive right into counting and working with single digit numerals. We will also introduce our literacy program (Learning Without Tears) and supportive activities to begin exploring letters, letter sounds, and high frequency words ("Popcorn Words"). Finally, we will begin to explore autumn themed curriculum, including apples and the change in weather. The children will frequently participate in reading/listening/language development, math, writing, social studies (personal-social skills), puzzles/games, art/creativity, dramatic play, literacy, and science and discovery. Our specials each week will include: Amazing Athletes, Gym, Library, Where in the World Wednesday, Executive Functioning skills practice (ELEVATE), Book Club, and Music Class. Art, science, social studies, and other enrichment opportunities will also be integrated into structured play times, Learning Stations, and fine motor activities. Please remember that the Yellow Kindergarten Room's academic day begins at 9 a.m. and we like to get busy right away so we can make the most of our time together! Don't forget to check email, your child's mail, and the Spotted Zebra website for more important information regarding our program. We are looking forward to an exciting year of learning and growing together!
